Treasurer's report:

The Bunnings sausage sizzle fundraiser made a profit of \$1022.99. Raffle ticket sales totalled \$500. Five trays of sausages were left over and these have been frozen to be used for the Sunset BBQ.

Total funds available as at 14/10/13 are \$3,390.91

Principal's report:

We were successful in getting funding for the Active After School Care (AASC) program. This is great news. Charmaine sent a letter to Luke Hartsuyker which may have helped.

Katrina Meenahan is back at school.

A 3D TV was purchased for the new 3-6K classroom and is set up on the wall with a wall bracket and an Apple TV box. Cost for this was approximately \$1400. Graeme asked if the P&C could pay for half of this cost.

Graeme is looking at getting a printer for the 3-6K classroom (rather than using the office printer). Will look at one donated by Irene to see if it can be set up with the network, or else looking at a laser printer for \$450.

We were successful in getting funding for the Live Life Well program, which means a grant of \$2000. Part of this will fund the chooks and chook pen. The chook pen is waiting on some fencing to be done between the neighbouring paddock (an offer to fund half of the materials and do the work has been made by the neighbour).

P&C have already agreed to fund part of the buses expense for the Lake Ainsworth excursion (approx. \$700), and a request to pay for the buses for a K-2M excursion later this term was made (approx. cost of \$300).

Graeme thought we might consider taking Bill Hodgson up on his offer of the freezer. This would not need to be kept running all the time, but would be useful for various events such as the Bunning BBQ (for freezing ice and etc). He will speak to the grounds person with regards to finding a space where power is available and it can be stored.

Year 6 Farewell party set for Tuesday 17 December.
