Porcupine Meatballs

750 g beef mince
½ cup uncooked rice
1 small onion, finely diced
1 teaspoon salt
1 teas pepper
2 teaspoons dried mixed herbs
2 x 500 g tins condensed tomato soup
1 ¼ cups water.

Mix mince, rice onion, herbs and seasoning together in a bowl. Shape into bite-sized balls. Heat tomato soup and water until boiling, then drop in meatballs. Simmer for 45 minutes.
