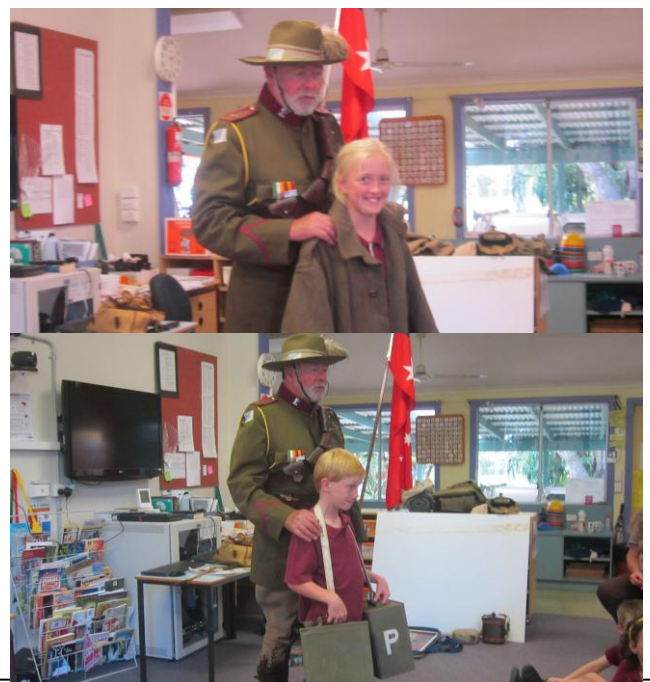
Brochures have been handed out to interested students. Orders and payment need to be returned to school by Wednesday 15th May. Cheques may be made out to Raleigh Public School.
