## Last Kik K-2M

Here are the recipes from K-2M. I'm sure you'll love making them at home.

### Bean Nachos

200g corn tortilla (5 tortillas)  
1 x 3 second spray(s) oil spray  
200g whole tomato canned in tomato juice, or fresh  
2 cups canned refried beans  
1 serve IGA Signature Seasoning, Taco

### Method

Combine the tomato, beans and taco seasoning in a small saucepan. Heat over medium low heat, then divide amongst 4 shallow bowls. Surround it with Nachos, add a dollop of sour cream and enjoy.

### Guacamole

2 ripe avocados, halved, stones removed, peeled  
1 small red onion finely chopped  
1 ripe tomato, finely chopped  
2 garlic cloves crushed  
Juice of 1 fresh lime and salt & pepper to taste

### Method

Place the avocado flesh in a medium bowl and use a fork to mash until almost smooth.  
Add the onion, tomato, garlic, chilli and lime juice and use a spoon to mix well. Taste and season with salt and pepper.
