Chicken Pox

There has been a case of Chicken Pox in our school community. Please monitor your child closely if they develop a rash or slight fever.

Time from exposure to illness: 2-3 weeks

Symptoms: Slight fever, runny nose and a rash that begins as raised pink spots that blister and scab. It can be more severe in pregnant women and newborns.

Students should be kept home for 5 days after the rash first appears and until the blisters have all scabbed over.

Immunisation is available for children over 12 months. It is recommended for people over 12 years who are not immune.
