### P&C Meeting

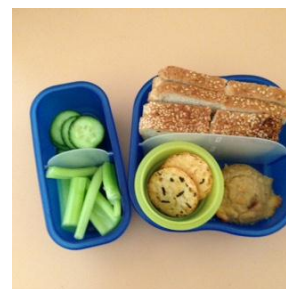
