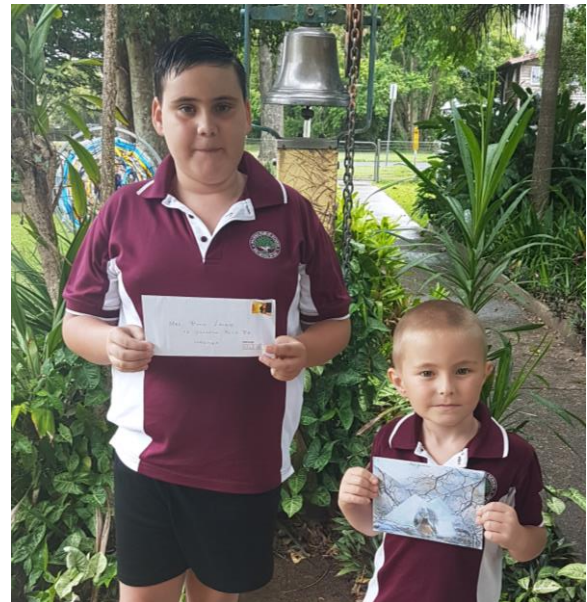

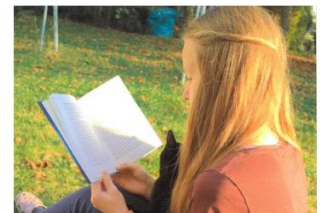
- Hosting is voluntary

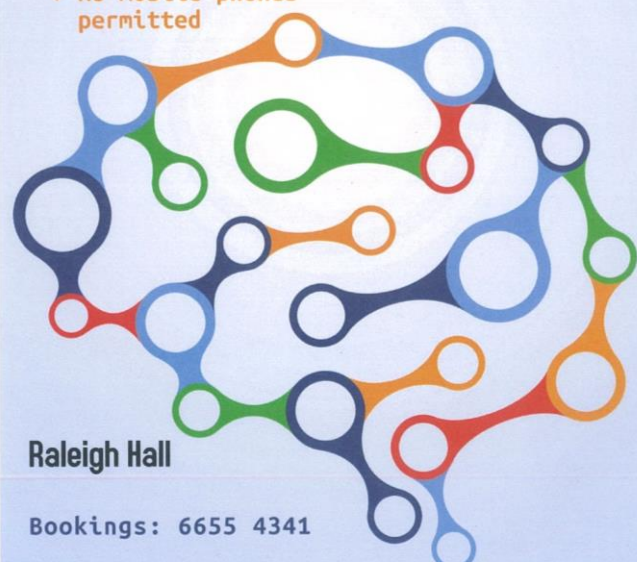
