Yesterday we had Natalie, a Y-PEP facilitator come and complete lesson two and three with each class. These valuable child protection lessons, which we have been able to access via a program from the YWCA are a means to ensuring the safety of our children. Students learnt about safe relationships, good and bad feelings and our bodies warning signs. They also discussed trusted adults and why it is important to have people that they feel comfortable to talk to, this could be mum or dad, a teacher or another adult they trust. They then learnt about the No, Go, Tell! Strategy and practiced this. Each class will complete lesson 4 with their classroom teacher in the coming weeks.

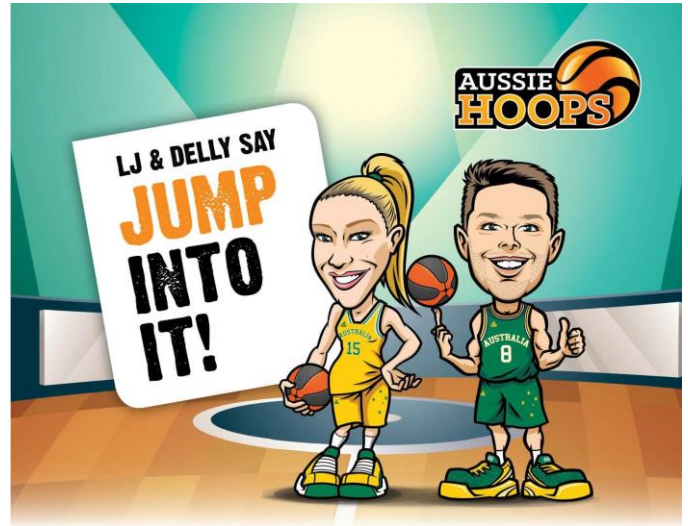
